Time commitment + Location: 35-40 hours per week July 2 - August 10, 2018 in our Brooklyn Camp Location. The Assistant Camp Director is expected to attend a paid Staff Orientation and Training in June with opportunities to work on camp programming in the coming months prior to camp and a post-camp evaluation.
